**DECLARATION OF SADIA
DURRANI IN SUPPORT OF FINAL
APPROVAL**

1 I, Sadia Durrani, hereby declare under penalty of perjury pursuant to 28
2 U.S.C. § 1746 as follows:

3 1. I am a named plaintiff in the above-captioned case. I have personal
4 knowledge of the facts stated herein and, if called upon to testify, would be
5 competent to do so.

6 2. In 2019, I purchased a 2020 Honda Pilot in Frisco, Texas.

7 3. My vehicle suffered from the AIS No-Restart defect on numerous
8 occasions since I purchased it.

9 4. Prior to the filing of the Second Amended Complaint in this action,
10 I contacted Class Counsel regarding the AIS No-Restart defect, and I retained
11 Class Counsel to represent me in this case. I agreed to act as a representative
12 plaintiff in a class action litigation, with the understanding that I agreed to act in
13 the best interests of the class.

14 5. My interests are aligned with those of the Settlement Class.
15 Throughout the course of the litigation, I have sought to help purchasers and
16 lessees of vehicles suffering from, or subject to, the AIS No-Restart defect receive
17 reasonable relief from Honda. I do not have any interests that are antagonistic to
18 or conflicts with the interests of the Settlement Class.

19 6. Since joining the case, I have communicated with my attorneys to
20 keep myself updated regarding what was happening in the case and to answer my
21 attorneys' questions regarding my individual facts and circumstances. The
22 communications included, among other things, initial conversations regarding the
23 issues with my vehicle, verifying information prior to joining this action, updating
24 my attorneys on any change in status in my efforts to get the AIS No-Restart defect
25 repaired, discussing the status of the litigation, and discussing the status of
26 settlement discussions.

27 7. I searched for and produced responsive documents in response to
28 Honda's document requests, and I provided information in response to Honda's

1 interrogatories. I spent numerous hours preparing for and, on February 27, 2024,
2 testifying in a deposition, conducted by Honda's counsel, lasting approximately
3 five hours.

4 8. I estimate that I have spent approximately 50 hours participating in,
5 and performing work relating to, this action.

6 9. I have reviewed the terms of the Settlement and believe that the
7 benefits provided by the Settlement represent an excellent result for the Settlement
8 Class. Specifically, I believe that Honda's agreement to provide a free starter
9 replacement without requiring that its dealers or service centers first verify that a
10 vehicle is suffering from the AIS No-Restart defect is a very significant benefit.
11 From my own experience with the AIS No-Restart defect, I know that it happens
12 intermittently and that one cannot reasonably expect that the problem can be
13 duplicated, or verified, by any service center or dealership.

14 10. My vehicle suffered from the AIS No-Restart defect after receiving
15 the software update described in the Honda service bulletins referenced in the
16 Settlement.

17 11. Prior to implementation of the amended service bulletins, pursuant
18 to the Settlement, I attempted to receive a remedy to the AIS No-Restart defect
19 and the service center at David McDavid Honda Dealership refused to provide me
20 with a free starter replacement because they stated that they could not verify the
21 defect.

22 12. In January 2024, I traded in my vehicle due to on-going concerns
23 regarding my family's safety while using it.

24 13. I understand that under the Settlement, Class Counsel will request
25 that the Court award each Class Representative, including myself, an incentive
26 award of \$7,500.

27 14. I have been informed and understand that whether I receive an
28 incentive award payment and, if so, in what amount, is entirely up to the Court. I

1 also understand that the incentive awards are to be considered by the Court
2 separately from whether the Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate, and that
3 if the Court declines to award the requested incentive awards, that determination
4 will not affect the validity or finality of the Settlement. My support of the
5 Settlement is not conditioned on an incentive award.

6 15. I also endorse the application for attorneys' fees by Class Counsel. I
7 believe Class Counsel should be awarded fair compensation for their significant
8 efforts since before the inception of this litigation, for the excellent result achieved,
9 and the substantial risks undertaken in this litigation.

10 16. I recommend the Settlement based on my belief that it is fair and
11 reasonable and in the best interest of the proposed Settlement Class.
